



# NOTICE: FRAUDULENT E-MAILS

It has come to Bank of Jamaica's attention that members of the public have been receiving e-mails circulated as if originating from BOJ, and from addresses associated with the Bank, purporting to inform persons about “new transaction guidelines,” “source of fund(s)” or other such headlines.

Bank of Jamaica wishes to advise stakeholders in the financial sector and the general public that these e-mails DO NOT originate from the Bank, and that BOJ has not disseminated any instructional messages to the public.

Importantly, persons in receipt of such messages should not proceed to open or execute any program contained therein, as we are advised that these emails have attachments which may contain malicious software.
