



SUMMER WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAMME 2013

Applications are being invited from suitably qualified candidates for participation in the Bank of Jamaica Summer Work Experience Programme (BOJ-SWEP) which is geared towards exposing students at the secondary and tertiary levels to a practical, professional and challenging work environment, whilst providing an opportunity for students to make a meaningful contribution to the operations of the Bank.

The BOJ-SWEP also includes partnerships with some educational institutions to facilitate internships for students pursuing courses of study with a mandatory internship component in the following disciplines: Economics (Postgraduate), Library and Information Studies and Law.

Duration

The normal duration of the engagement of students is six (6) weeks. The programme commences in June and ends in August of each year.

Selection Criteria

The limited number of spaces will be filled from the list of candidates who meet the following criteria:

- i. be enrolled in a full-time programme at a secondary or tertiary educational institution.
- ii. have completed Grade 10 at the Secondary Level and be at least 16 years of age.
- iii. be pursuing a course of study that is consistent with the skills required in the operations of the Bank.
- iv. not be children or near relatives (that is, husband, wife, brother, sister) of employees of the Bank of Jamaica.
- v. not have participated in the programme twice prior to the current year.
