POSITION OF DEPUTY SUPERVISOR
(Pursuant to Section 34B of the Banking Services Act, 2014)**

Bank of Jamaica invites applications from suitably qualified senior professionals to join its Executive Management Team in the statutory position of **Deputy Supervisor (Deputy Governor, Financial Institutions Supervisory Division)**.

The statutory position of Deputy Supervisor also heads the Financial Institutions Supervisory Division (FISD) in the capacity of Deputy Governor. The position plays an important role in providing high level technical support and advice to the Governor in his capacity as the Supervisor in executing the banking supervision mandate and ensuring the effectiveness of the Supervisory framework. The incumbent must demonstrate the ability to exercise sound judgment in a highly complex environment, to manage and rank competing priorities, successfully lead, influence and manage change in Bank of Jamaica's responsibilities, inspiring confidence and credibility both within the institution and throughout the financial sector.

The successful candidate will have strategic oversight of the FISD operations to include promoting the safety, soundness, integrity and stability of the banking system by ensuring that Bank of Jamaica establishes the appropriate policy framework and operational infrastructure to satisfy its statutory and prudential responsibilities with regard to the supervision of deposit-taking institutions. He or she will also participate as a member of the Supervisory Committee as prescribed under the Banking Services Act, 2014 and will undertake the functions and responsibilities of the Supervisor in the absence of the incumbent.

The successful candidate must at a minimum possess post-graduate level qualifications in disciplines such as Finance or Economics, or professional certification in accounting such as ACCA or CPA, with exposure to management training at the executive level plus a minimum of 10 years' experience in a central bank, the public sector or financial sector with at least 5 years' experience at an executive management level.
