NOTICE

Bank of Jamaica (“the Bank”) has been made aware of the existence of a document entitled: “INDEMNITY FOR INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY FACSIMILE TRANSMISSION OR ELECTRONIC MAIL TRANSMISSION” dated 05 December 2011, which is represented as having been issued by the Bank to a commercial bank located overseas and copied to financial institutions in general. The document purports to be issued over the signatures of two members of the Bank's senior management.

The Bank hereby advises all financial institutions and the public in general that the said document is false and the signatures affixed to it are forgeries.

Any entity to which the said document may be presented should place no reliance whatsoever on it and is advised to contact the Bank immediately.
