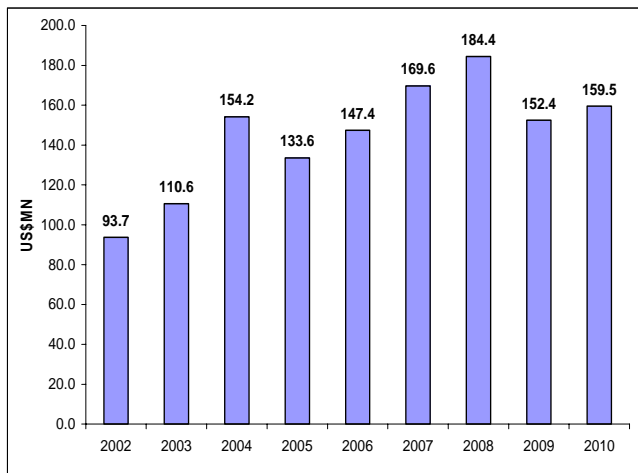

September 2010

For September 2010, net remittances were **US\$139.3 million**, which represented an improvement of **US\$6.3 million** or **4.7 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of 2009. (Table 1)

During the month, total remittance inflows were **US\$159.5 million**, an improvement of **US\$7.1 million** or **4.6 per cent**. The increase in total remittance inflows emanated from both *Remittance Companies* and the *Other Remittances* sub-categories. In terms of the *Remittance Companies* category, an increase of **US\$2.8 million** was realized. Remittances recorded in the *Other Remittances* category was **US\$27.1 million**, representing an increase of **18.6 per cent** relative to the corresponding period in 2009.

For the month, remittance inflows of **US\$159.5 million** represent a reversal of the decline noted in September 2009 (Graph 1). This improvement resulted primarily from increases in total remittance inflows through Remittance companies.

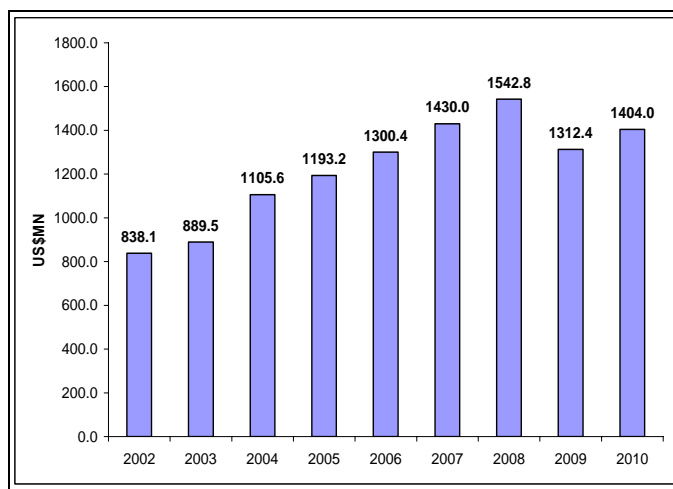

January to September 2010

For the first nine months of the 2010 calendar year, net remittances were **US\$1,220.1 million**, which represented an increase of **US\$85.2 million** or **7.5 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of 2009 (Table 2).

For the calendar year, total remittance inflows were **US\$1,404.0 million**, representing an increase of **US\$91.6 million** or **7.0 per cent**. This increase in total remittance inflows emanated mainly from improvements in inflows to *Remittance Companies* which recorded total inflows of **US\$1,189.6 million**, a **US\$73.4 million** or **6.6 per cent** improvement compared to the corresponding period in 2009.

Although marginally better than the corresponding period in 2009, remittance inflows of **US\$1,404.0 million** were still below the pre-crisis (2008) trend (Graph 2). A continued improvement in remittance inflows in ensuing months is juxtaposed on the improving macroeconomic conditions in source economies.

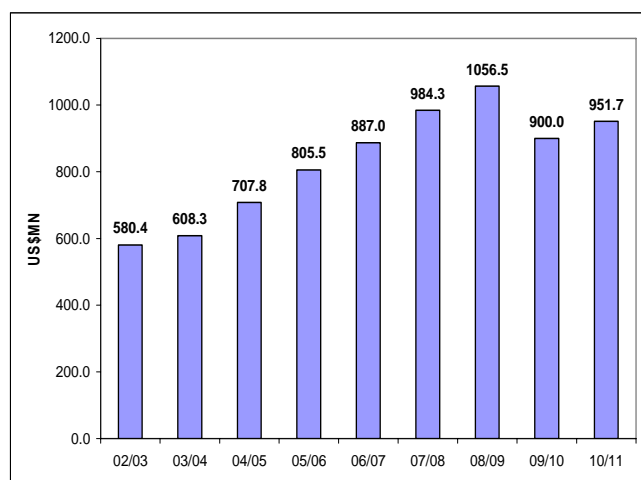

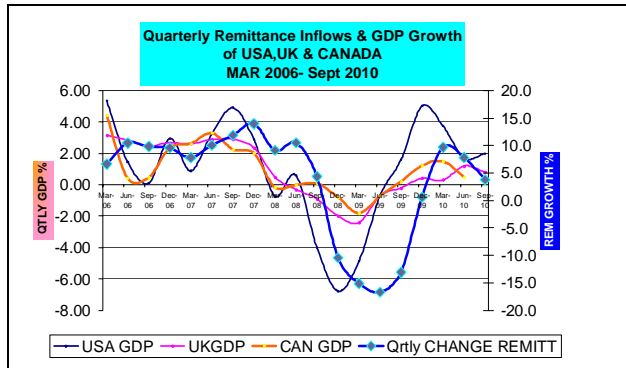
April to September 2010/11

For the first six months of the 2010/11 fiscal year (FY), net remittances were **US\$818.9 million**, which represented an increase of **US\$40.7 million** or **5.2 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year.

For the FY-to-date, total remittance inflows were **US\$951.7 million**, representing an increase of **US\$51.6 million** or **5.7 per cent** over the preceding fiscal year. The increase in total remittance inflows emanated from both *Remittance Companies* and the *Other Remittances* sub-categories. In terms of *Other Remittances*, an increase of **US\$15.6 million** or **11.7 per cent** was realized. The *Remittance Companies* category also recorded increases where total inflows of **US\$803.4 million**, represented a **US\$36.1 million** or **4.7 per cent** improvement compared to the corresponding period in fiscal year 2009/10.

The remittance inflows of **US\$951.7 million** for the first six months of the 2010/11 fiscal year represents a reversal of the decline noted in the corresponding period in fiscal year 2009/10 (Graph 3). This was consistent with the global developments occurring during the review period.

Remittance inflows have exhibited a positive relationship with the rate of economic recovery in major source countries (Graph 4). As these economies recover, remittance flows are expected to improve over ensuing quarters.

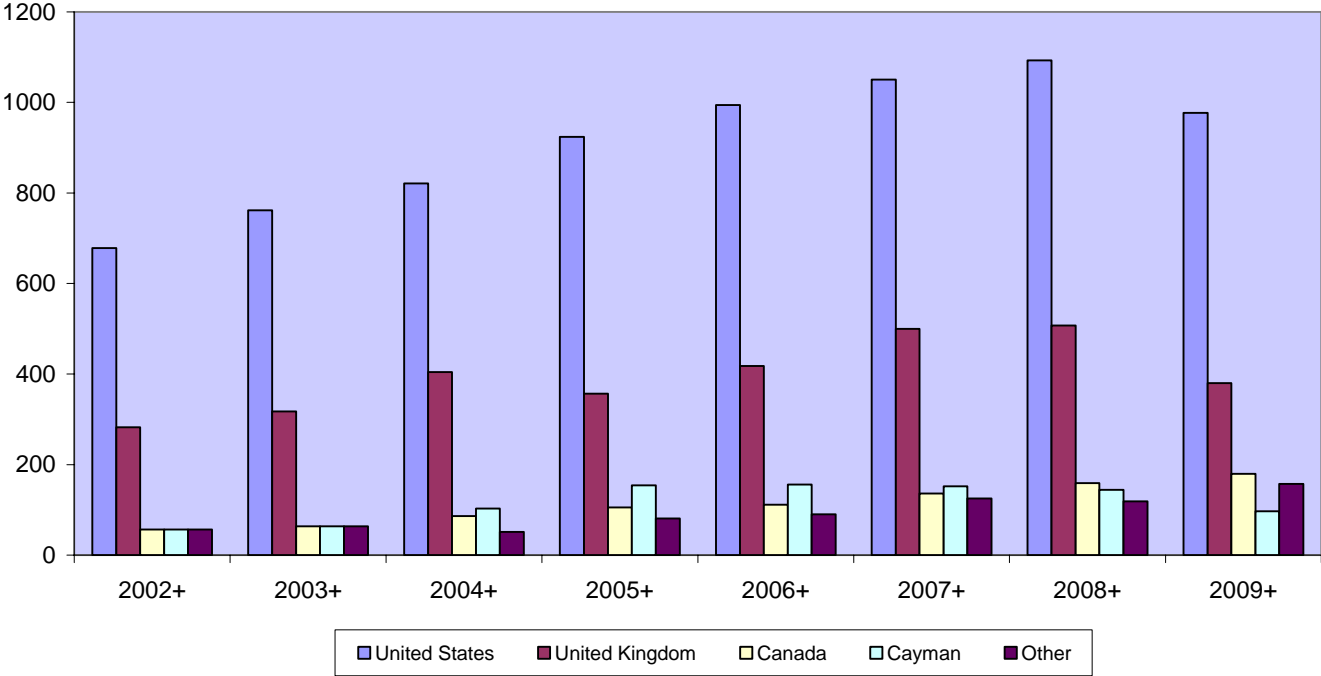
