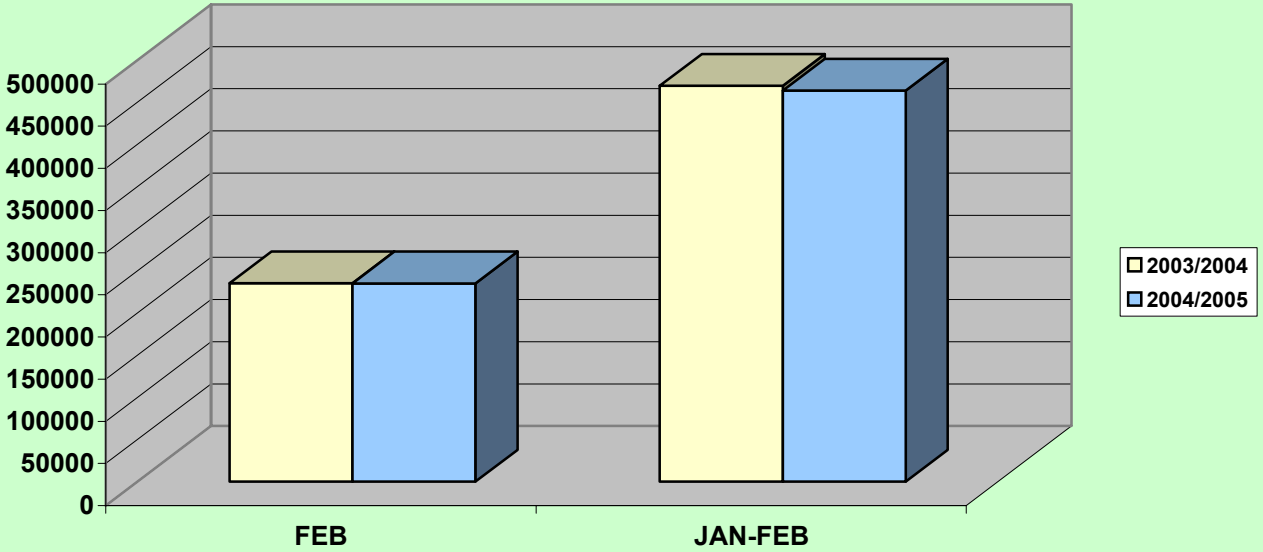

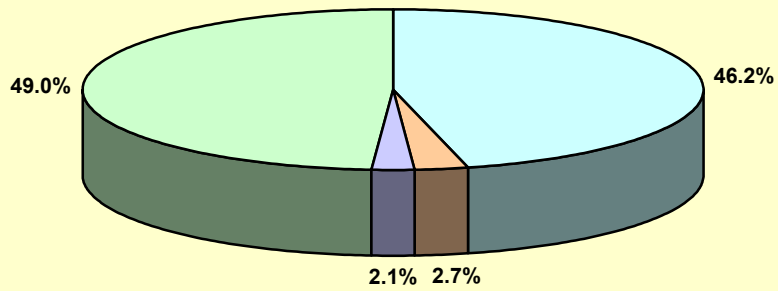
**Estimated Tourist Expenditure

Jamaica: Total Visitors

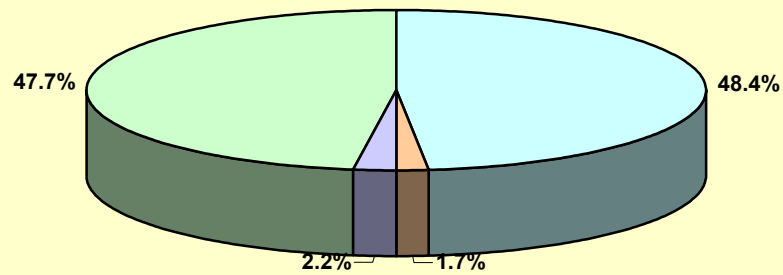


Composition of Visitors February 2004

Composition of Visitors February 2005

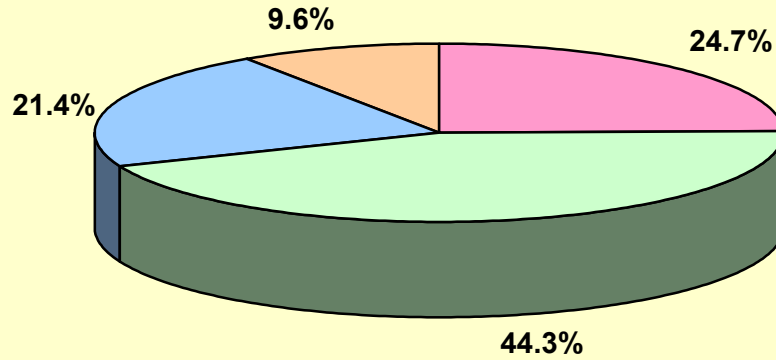

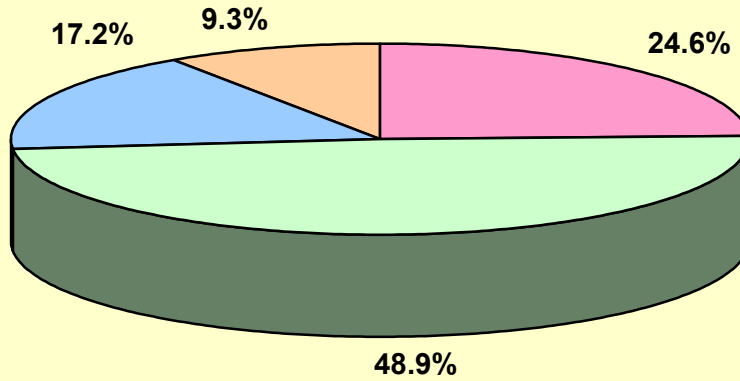
