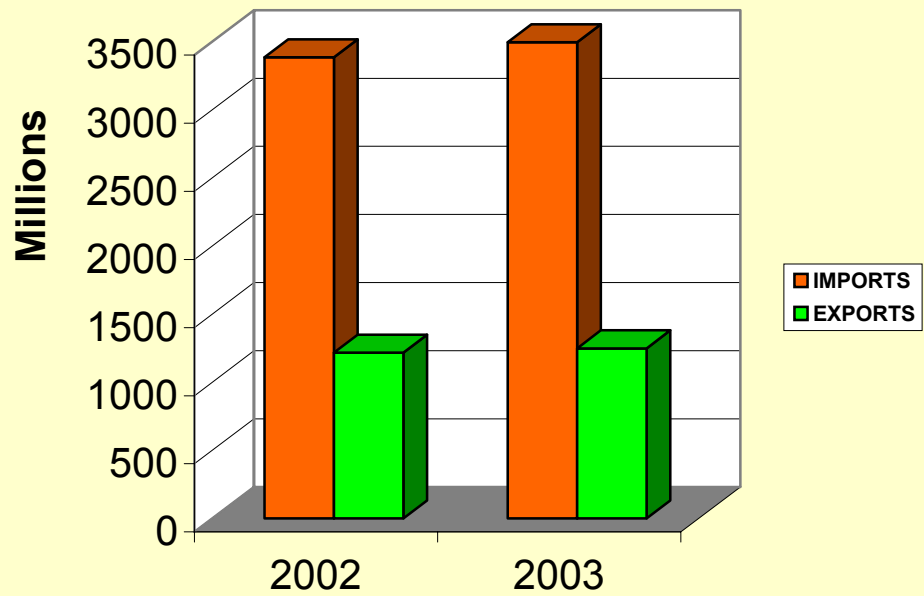

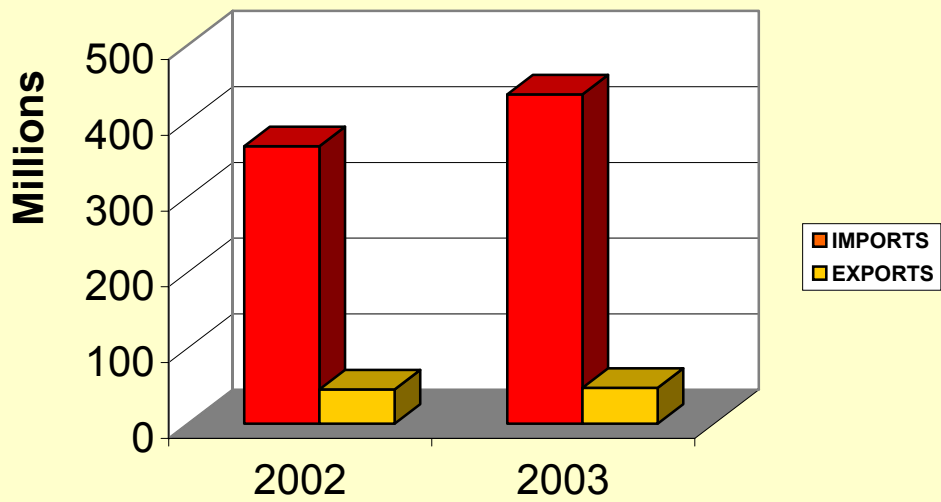

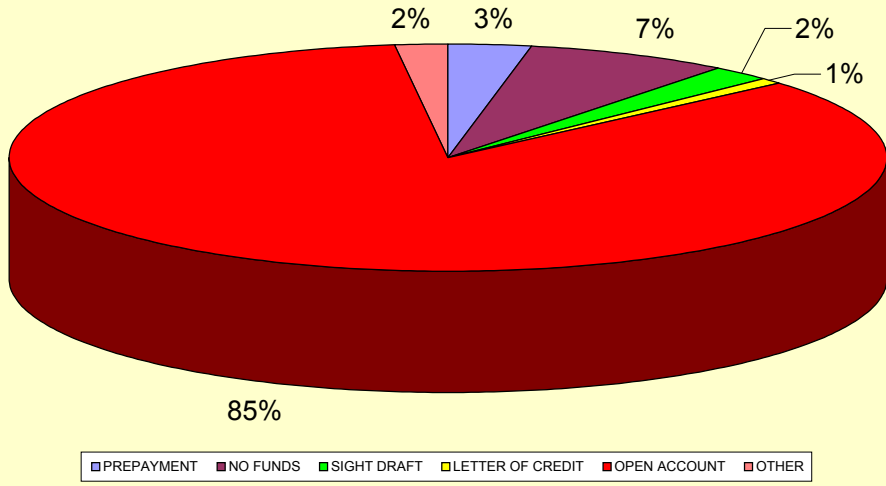

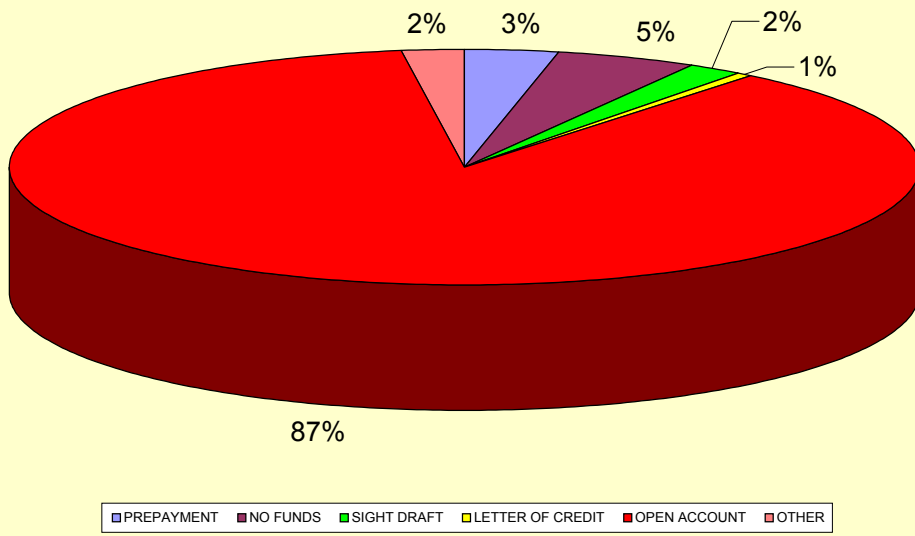

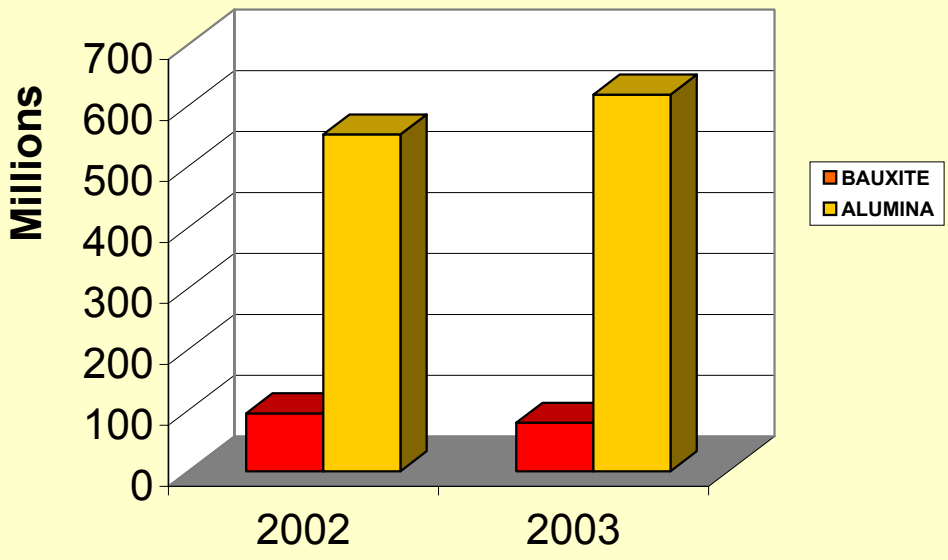

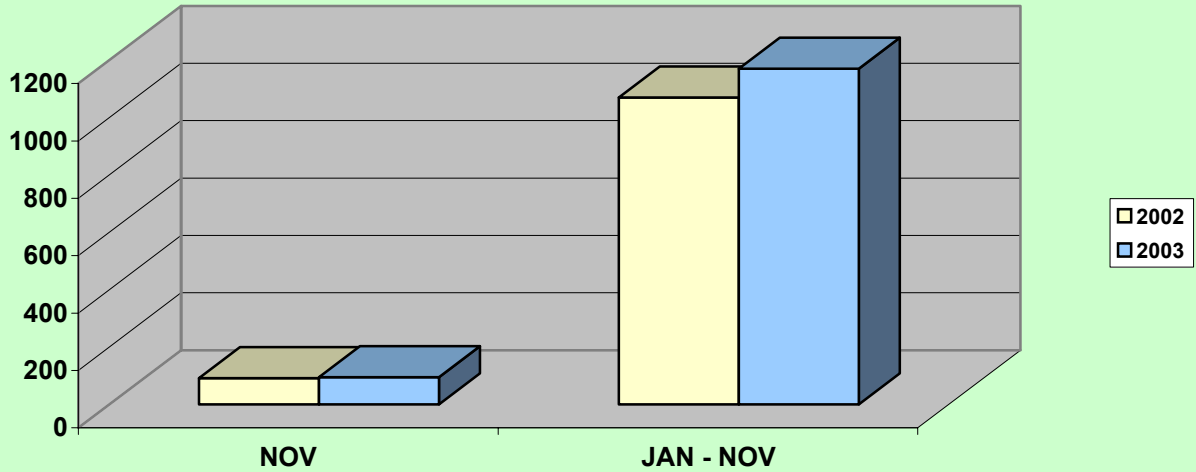

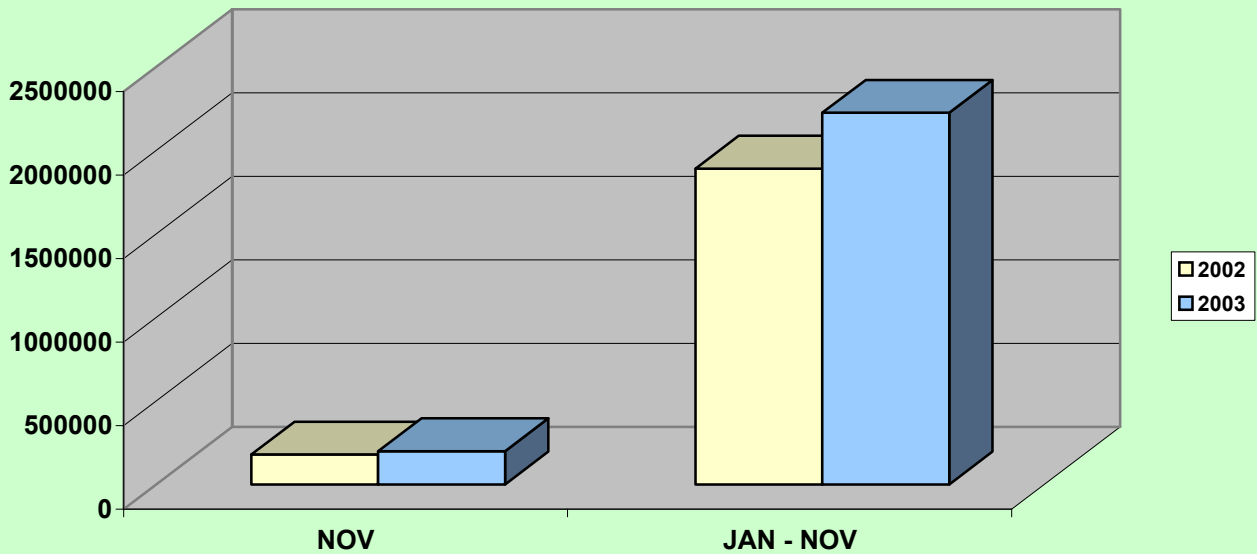

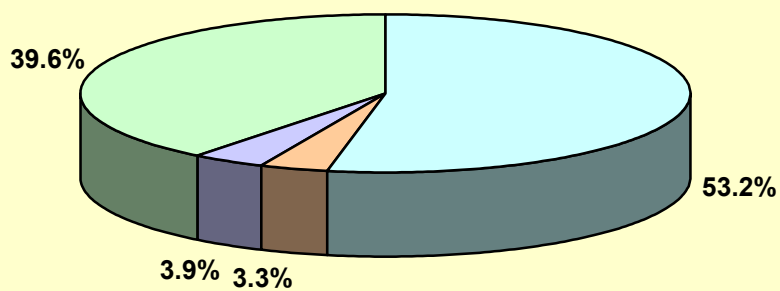
**Estimated Tourist Expenditure

Jamaica: Total Visitors

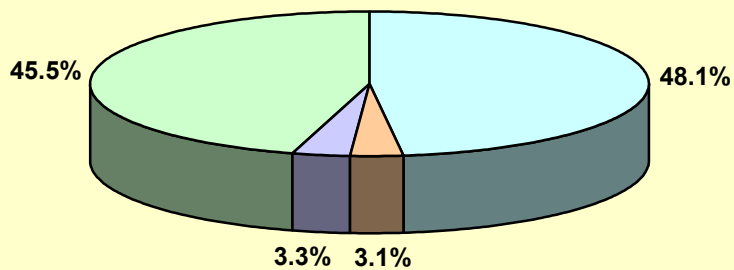


Composition of Visitors January - November 2002

Composition of Visitors January - November 2003



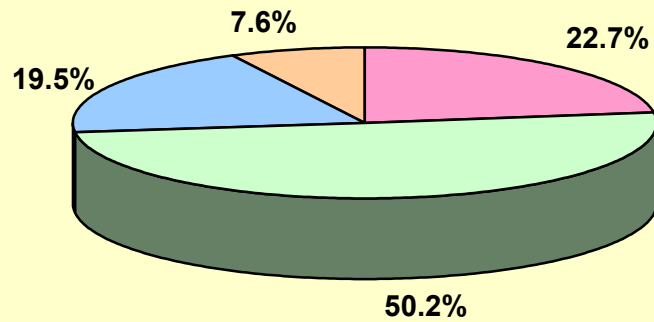

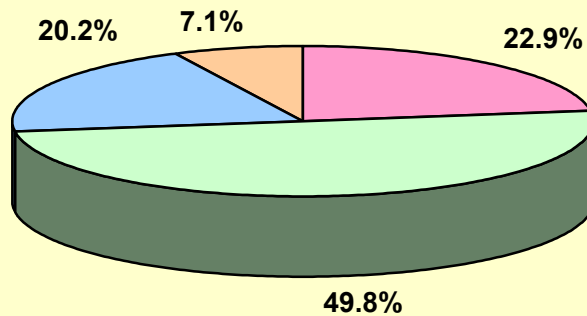
