

May 2012

For May 2012, net remittances were **US\$142.4 million**, which represented a marginal increase of **US\$0.1 million** or **0.1 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of 2011 (Table 1). This resulted from an increase in gross inflows which were partially offset by an increase in remittance outflows.

During the month, total remittance inflows were US\$166.7 million, an improvement of US\$0.6 million or 0.3 per cent growth relative to the corresponding month of the previous year. The growth in total remittance inflows emanated from increased flows through the *Remittance Companies* of US\$1.9 million (Table 1). For the review month, increases in outflows of US\$0.5 million partially offset the marginal growth in net remittances.

Total remittance inflows of **US\$166.7 million**, for the month of May, was above the previous five year monthly average of **US\$163.1million** (Graph 1). This improvement resulted primarily from increased inflows through Remittance Companies.

January to May 2012

For the first five months of 2012, net remittances were **US\$737.8 million**, which represented a growth of **US\$22.0 million** or **3.1 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of 2011 (Table 2). This resulted from an increase in gross inflows, though partially offset by an upturn in gross remittance outflows.

For the review period, total remittance inflows were US\$851.6 million, representing an increase of US\$30.7 million or 3.7 per cent relative to the corresponding period of the previous calendar year. The upturn in total remittance inflows emanated from improvements in inflows to both the Remittance Companies and the Other Remittances sub-categories. Remittance Companies recorded an increase of US\$29.7 million or 4.3 per cent, while Other Remittances grew by US\$1.0 million or 0.8 per cent compared to the corresponding period in 2011. For the review period, growth in outflows of US\$8.7 million partially offset the increase in net remittances.


Gross remittance inflows of **US\$851.6 million** was above the five year average of **US\$779.7 million** (Graph 2). This occurred notwithstanding continued economic downturn in Europe as well as a slower pace of growth in the United States.

April to May 2012/13

For the first two months of the 2012/13 fiscal year (FY), net remittances were **US\$301.2 million**, which represented an increase of **US\$6.6 million** or **2.3 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year. This resulted from both a positive growth in gross inflows and a reduction in remittance outflows.

For the FY-to-May, total remittance inflows were US\$346.8 million, representing an increase of US\$5.6 million or 1.6 per cent over the corresponding period of the preceding fiscal year. The positive growth in total remittance emanated from an increase in flows through the Remittance Companies of US\$6.8 million or 2.3 per cent. For the review period, the decrease in outflows of US\$1.0 million also contributed to the positive growth in net remittances.

The remittance inflows of **US\$346.8 million** for the first two months of the 2012/13 fiscal year represents the largest inflow since FY 2008/09 (Graph 3). Remittance inflows continued to do well despite unfavourable macroeconomic conditions in the source economies.




