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

November 2010

For November 2010, net remittances were **US\$129.5 million**, which represented an improvement of **US\$7.7 million** or **6.3 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of 2009. (Table 1) This resulted from an increase in gross inflows and a decline in remittance outflows.

During the month, total remittance inflows were US\$150.1 million, an improvement of US\$7.4 million or 5.2 per cent. This improvement emanated from a US\$7.9 million increase in the *Remittance Companies* sub-category. The increase in total remittance inflows was marginally offset by a US\$0.5 million decline in the *Other Remittances* sub-category (Table 1). For the review month, a decline in remittance outflows of US\$0.3 million, further contributed to the positive growth in net remittances


For the month, remittance inflows of **US\$150.1 million,** despite being below the pre-crisis level recorded in 2007, represent a continuation of the increase noted in November 2009 (Graph 1). This improvement resulted primarily from increased inflows through Remittance companies.

January to November 2010

For eleven months of the 2010 calendar year, remittances were US\$1,487.8 million, which represented an increase of US\$91.6 million or 6.6 per cent relative to the corresponding period of 2009 (Table 2).

For the calendar year to November, total remittance inflows were US\$1,713.0 million, representing an increase of **US\$103.6 million** or **6.4 per cent.** This increase in total remittance inflows emanated mainly from improvements in inflows to both the Remittance Companies, and the Other Remittances sub-categories. Remittance Companies recorded an increase of US\$81.2 million or 5.9 per cent US\$43.8 million or 4.3 per cent, while Other Remittances had an increase of US\$22.4 million or **9.4 per cent** compared to the corresponding period in 2009. The increase in net remittances was partially offset by an increase in outflows of US\$12.0 million.

Although marginally better than the corresponding period in 2009, remittance inflows of US\$1,713.0 million were still below the pre-crisis (2008) trend (Graph 2). A continued improvement in remittance inflows in ensuing months is juxtaposed on the improving macroeconomic conditions in source economies.



April to November 2010/11

For the first eight months of the 2010/11 fiscal year (FY), net remittances were **US\$1,086.6 million**, which represented an increase of **US\$46.8 million** or **4.5 per cent** relative to the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year.

For the FY-to-November, total remittance inflows were US\$1,260.7 million, representing an increase of US\$63.7 million or 5.3 per cent over the corresponding period of the preceding fiscal year. The increase in total remittance inflows emanated from both *Remittance Companies* and the *Other Remittances* sub-categories. *Remittance Companies* recorded an increase of US\$43.8 million or 4.3 per cent, while *Other Remittances* had an increase of US\$19.8 million or 11.3 per cent. The increase in net remittances was partially offset by an increase in outflows of US\$16.8 million.

The remittance inflows of **US\$1,260.7 million** for the first eight months of the 2010/11 fiscal year represents a reversal of the decline noted in the corresponding period in fiscal year 2009/10 (Graph 3). This was consistent with the global developments occurring during the review period.
